SCHOLARSHIP:

Government provides NSP and SSP Scholarships to students ranging from minority to general category, to offer to deserving students.

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (NSP)

National Scholarships Portal is one-stop solution through which various services starting from student application, application receipt, processing, sanction and disbursal of various scholarships to Students are enabled. National Scholarships Portal is taken as Mission Mode Project under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP)

STATE SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL (SSP)

State Scholarship Portal (SSP) is an application for administering scholarships. This portal will be mandated for use by all Departments that disburse Scholarships.

HOW TO APPLY:

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (NSP)

Students applying for scholarship for the first time (Fresh Students) need to "Register" on the portal as fresh applicant by providing accurate and authenticated information as printed on their documents in the "Student Registration Form".

The registration form is required to be filled by parents / guardian of students who are below the age of 18 years on the date of registration.

Before initiating registration process, students / Parents / guardian are advised to keep the following documents handy:

- 1. Educational documents of student
- 2. Student's Bank account number and IFSC code of the bank branch

Note: For pre matric scholarship scheme, where students do not have their own bank account, parents can provide their own account details. However, parents account number can only be used against scholarship applications for maximum two children.

- 3. Aadhaar number of the Student
- 4. If Aadhaar is not available, then Bonafide student certificate from Institute / School and
- 5. Aadhaar Enrolment ID and Scanned copy of Bank passbook

6. If Institute/School is different from domicile state of the applicant, then Bonafide student certificate from Institute / School.

STATE SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL (SSP)

How to Apply Online For SSP Scholarship

- 1. You should start by going to the official website for the scholarship.
- 2. Click Create Account after the main page has loaded to access a new page.
- 3. On this new page, you must pick a plan.
- 4. You must now choose your caste or class.

WHO CAN APPLY

Eligibility Criteria for NSP Scholarship

The scholarship may be awarded to college students who have secured more than 50% marks in the previous very last examination, and their dad and mom/mother or father's annual income from all assets need to be between Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 8 lakh Per Annum.

Eligibility Criteria for SSP Post Matric Scholarship

- Domicile of Karnataka.
- Annual family income below Rs.2 lakh.
- Minimum 50% marks in this previous examination.
- Students seeking admission in 11th, 12th, B.Com, and ITI courses.
- Graduates from ST, SC, OBC, central OBC, EBC, and minority categories.
